2018 Dog Tags Are Available

SAVE UP TO 40% by getting your dog tag(s) before April 30th, 2018.

Door-to-door dog tag sales will be taking place from January until the end of April 2018. Payments may be made by cheque, cash, credit card, money order or debit. Residents are reminded that in accordance with North Dundas By-law 38-2000, all dogs within the Township of North Dundas must have a tag no later than April 30th of each year. Dog licenses may be purchased for \$20 each (\$15 for neutered or spayed dogs) before April 30th, or \$30 each (\$25 for neutered or spayed dogs) on or after April 30th, 2018.

Failure to have your dog(s) licensed could result in a fine.
