

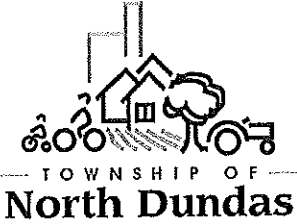

EXTENSION OF CONTRACTS

I would like to extend the contract for 1 year with Golder. (surface & groundwater consultants)

Golder is also involved with our application (D & O) to the Ministry of Environment. I believe the process would slow down if we had two consultants. Changes in the surface & groundwater or the D & O can be easily and quickly changed if the Ministry requires us to make changes by using one consultant.

I would also like to approach Hume Waste Disposal for a 1 year extension. With the expectation of the EPR (Extended Producer Responsibility) coming into effect, there will be many changes in waste management in how it is picked up and what is picked up. I believe there are changes that may need to be discussed by council about waste pickup before we tender our garbage contract out.
