PROPOSED 2015 WORK PROGRAM AND BUDGET FOR CONSULTING SERVICES MOUNTAIN AND BOYNE ROAD LANDFILLS TOWNSHIP OF NORTH DUNDAS, ONTARIO

Dear Doug:

As per your request by phone on October 30, 2014 this letter summarizes the proposed 2015 work program for monitoring and reporting for the Township of North Dundas (Township) Mountain Landfill and Boyne Road Landfill,

## **Proposed 2015 Work Program**

#### Boyne Road Landfill

The report on the 2014 monitoring program has not yet been completed. Therefore, for the purposes of this cost estimate, it is assumed that the 2015 groundwater and surface water monitoring programs will be identical to that described in Section 11 and summarized in Tables 9 and 10 (attached) of the 2013 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Program and Operations Monitoring Report.

The following tasks are proposed as part of the 2015 work program for the Boyne Road Landfill:

- Complete the spring and late summer groundwater monitoring sessions in accordance with Table 9 of the 2013 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Program and Operations Monitoring Report;
- Complete spring, late summer and late fall surface water monitoring sessions in accordance with Table 10 of the 2013 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Program and Operations Monitoring Report;
- 3) Complete a topographical survey of the Boyne Road Landfill. Survey information will be used to estimate the remaining site capacity for inclusion in the 2015 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Program and Operations Monitoring Report; and,
- 4) Complete the Boyne Road Landfill 2015 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Program and Operations Monitoring Report to be submitted to the MOE by March 31, 2016.





#### Mountain Landfill

The report on the 2013 and 2014 monitoring programs has not yet been completed. Therefore, for the purposes of this cost estimate, it is assumed that the 2015 groundwater monitoring program will be identical to that described in Section 7 and summarized in Table 4 (attached) of the 2011 and 2012 Groundwater Monitoring Program and Operations Report.

The following task is proposed as part of the 2015 work program for the Mountain Landfill:

 Complete spring and fall groundwater monitoring sessions in accordance with the applicable post-closure monitoring program.

A report summarizing and discussing the results of the 2015 and 2016 monitoring activities at the Mountain Landfill is anticipated to be completed by <u>March 31, 2017</u>. As such, preparation of this report is not included in the 2015 Work Program.

#### 2015 Work Program Estimated Costs

The estimated cost for undertaking the above noted tasks for each landfill is presented in the following table. Work will be billed on a time and materials basis in accordance with standard rates for the personnel involved. In this cost estimate, under the reporting task, we have allowed some time to respond to comments on the previous reports from the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change, advise the Township on matters that may arise, etc. It is noted that in past years we have typically been able to complete this work for less than the estimated cost; however, the following amounts are suggested for your budgeting purposes.
