Subject: Canada 150 Beautification Grant	Page 1 of 1

Purpose:

A Canada150 Beautification Fund of \$25,000 was proposed in the allocation of the 2016 North Dundas surplus. This one-time fund, which was created to celebrate Canada's 150th birthday, will provide grants in the form of matching funds for beautification projects in North Dundas.

Policy:

Community Organizations or Groups can request up to \$5,000 in matching funds for beautification projects in North Dundas. There is a limit of \$5,000 per Community Organization of Group, but each group can submit multiple applications that total \$5,000.

The following requirements must be met in order for a request to be reviewed by the committee:

- Submit a letter indicating who you are and what type of service your group/organization provides in the community of North Dundas.
- The letter must indicate what the funds are being used for and the impact on the community.
- The letter must indicate the amount of funding requested, to a maximum of 50% of the total project cost up to \$5,000 per project/group.
- The request should include sample photographs/designs of the proposed beautification and a map indicating location(s) of the project components.

Projects must be completed by December 31st, 2017.

The first application review deadline is May 1st. Additional applications will be reviewed on a first come, first served basis until all funding is allocated. There is a limit of \$5,000 per group/organization.

The review committee shall consist of the Director of Recreation & Culture, the CAO, Councillor Armstrong and Councillor Thompson. The review committee will make the final decision on the award of grants.

Funds will be paid upon submission of supplier invoices by the Community Organization/Group.

Upon completion of the project, the Community Organization/Group agrees to provide "before" and "after" photos of the project that can be used by the Township for promotional purposes.
