Get Your 2017 Dog Tags

Residents are reminded that every owner of a dog needs to have their dogs tagged no later than March 31 in each year or within "7" days of becoming an owner. In accordance with By-law 38-2000, all dogs within the Township of North Dundas must be licensed each year. We accept cash, cheque, debit and credit card as forms of payment at the Township Office. Failure to have your dog(s) licensed could result in a fine.
