1. Proposed Employee Group Benefits Consortium

Mosey & Mosey Benefit Plan Consultants were retained by the United Counties of SD&G to undertake a feasibility study and marketing to determine the merits of a Group Benefits Consortium. All lower tier municipalities in the Counties were invited to join. The resulting consortium consists of the Counties, the Townships of North and South Glengarry, the Township of South Stormont and the Township of North Dundas. The requests for proposal were sent to eleven insurers. Five carriers submitted complete proposals. Mosey & Mosey recommended the proposal submitted by La Capitale/Green Shield. It provides the best overall price and the longest rate guarantee period. The price submitted for the Township of North Dundas results in annual savings of approximately \$50,000 over our current premium (see attached). Our current policy expires on September 30, 2012, but we can cancel earlier with 60 days notice. The Counties have suggested an August 1st implementation date for the group. I recommend that we accept the proposed Group Benefits Plan submitted by La Capitale/Green Shield with an August 1st implementation date.

2. Director of Recreation & Culture

Mark Guy, our Director of Recreation & Culture for the last ten years, has accepted a position with the Township of North Grenville. His last day with the Township of North Dundas will be May 25th. Mark will be missed as he has been a valuable employee and has guided the growth and development of North Dundas' recreation program over the past ten years to one that is emulated by our neighbours. I have attached the existing Director of Recreation & Culture job description for Council's review. If Council would like to see any changes, now is the time to make any revisions.
