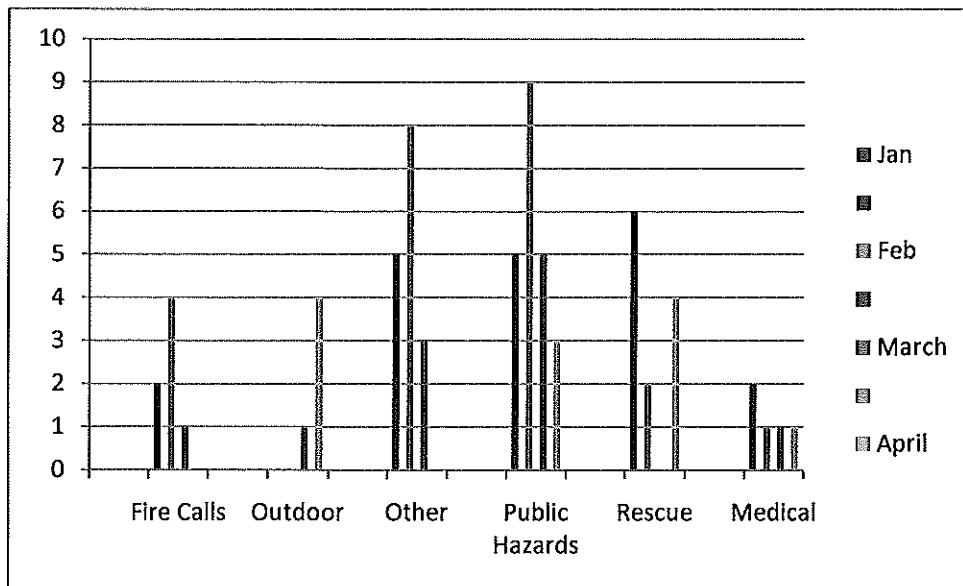
Glossary of terms.

- Fire calls are counted as working fires that affect structures of value.
- Outdoor calls are grass/brush fires or any other fires of non value.
- Other calls are mutual aid (assisting other townships), automatic aid (assisting departments within our township) and assisting other agencies such as Police, MOL, MOE, TSSA etc.
- Public Hazard calls include CO2 alarms, gas leaks, hydro, false alarms etc.
- Rescue calls consist of vehicle collisions, vehicle fires, confined space rescue and all other types of rescue.
- Medical calls are either to assist the ambulance or first response.
