To: From Date of Meeting: Subject:	CAO, Mayor and Members of Council Dan Belleau – Director of Transportation October 16, 2012 Public Works Department Monthly Report (September)
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Road Construction: The construction of the road base in preparation for Surface Treatment for Guy Rd, Baker Rd, French Settlement, Loughlin Ridge Rd and Allen Rd, is completed. Waiting for Surface Treatment, last conversation with contractor they are running one week behind schedule.

Boyd parking lot: Construction of parking lot is completed; we are now waiting for paving contractor to complete. Last conversation with Cruickshank they are planning to be here the week of the October 15th, 2012 weather permitted.

Mountain Boundary Rd: At one time there was a concern of damage to the new surface treatment due to heavy truck traffic, on August 14, 2012 both Townships Roads department met with the contractor Smith Construction on Mountain Boundary Road, attached is letter from the contractor explaining the rutting on the one section of road. On October 2, 2012, the Townships road department met with North Grenville roads department to discuss the issue of truck traffic on Mountain Boundary road. A few ideas were put on the table like, approaching MNR to review the pit license and designate a truck route, make it a non truck route without interfering with possible future development in the area, reducing the speed limit to discourage heavy trucks. Since the Township of North Grenville has contacted Lafarge and asked if they would not use the Boundary road as a haul route, both Townships have notice a big reduction of truck traffic at the exception of the occasional one. Both parties agreed that a traffic count and speed limit study should take place before any decision is made.

Road Side Boom Mower & Tractor: Tractor was delivered on September 19, 2012
 Boom Mower will be delivered in January or February, 2013.

Road Side Brush Cutting: I have hired Frank Ault Const to do more Road side brush cutting, with the left over funds from the grass cutting contract.


Equipment: Attached is a list of surplus equipment for council to consider.



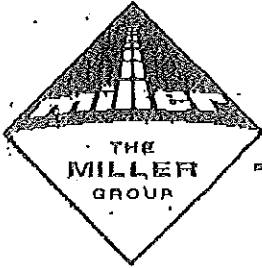
