Subject:	Public Works Monthly Update (Nov)

In the month of November the crew changed a culvert on Kerr's Ridge Rd (1400x8M) along with cold patching and some hot patching on various roads throughout the township.

On Kittle Rd a hicka bottom was installed where water was standing, and in Winchester on Clarence St a sump line was repaired that had failed.

Our backhoe operator dug a trench for the South Mountain Library for some hydro work that was required.

I meet with the owner of Rick's Paving over the paving job that they completed throughout Winchester, I asked him to reset the water valve lids he had them too high.

On Nov/3/11 I meet with Gerry Boyce and Brain Halpenny over drainage problems on Bridge St in South Mountain, we are looking at doing some ditching along Bridge St next summer.

Embrun Sanitation was called to flush out a culvert on Maple Ridge Rd and a drain on St Lawrence St.

The graders have been working on our roads preparing them for winter freeze up. The winter parking restriction signs have been installed and the advertisement in the newspaper has been placed. The park benches and garbage cans have been picked up throughout Winchester and Chesterville. The Christmas lights have been installed throughout Winchester and Chesterville for the winter season. John Oswald attended an Ontario Roads Superintendents meeting Wednesday/16.


