Subject:	Public Works Monthly Update (October)

Five laneway culverts on Old Carriage Land have been lowered, reset and payment reinstated.

A new catch basin was installed in front of Currans Flooring. A laneway culvert at the end of Byers Rd (in front of the body shop) was dug up and repaired.

The men assisted OCWA with traffic control during the repair of water valves on St Lawrence St and Gladstone St.

Our winter stone dust has been stock piled in the dome. We used a conveyer to complete this. White Tail Construction was hired to do the repairs on the entrance of the dome. The work was completed on Friday October 28/11.

The men have been working on cleaning the yards and recycling the old culverts and used blades. A total of \$4278.03 has been handed in.

Cold patching has been on going along with grading of gravel roads. The propane Hotbox has been returned to Marathon and we are waiting for the new oil heated Hotbox.

The sidewalk at the end of William St in Chesterville by the dam has been removed and a new sub base has been replaced. Price Paving has reinstated the new sidewalk, top soiling along the sides of the sidewalk is also complete.

Two culverts have been replaced on Mountain Boundary Rd just past Eastern Monuments.

Our Mechanic has been working on getting our winter maintenance equipment ready for this season along with repairs on other department vehicles.


I met with Claude Tailon from Stantec to review the paving job in the Winfield Subdivision in Winchester.
