- Cold patching continues throughout August on all roads. The men have been working on Sign repairs and replacement.
- The rest of the bricks for the sidewalks in Winchester have been picked up and stock piled at the Hydro One yard
- The main garage and the MTO yard is in the process of being cleaned up
- Louise St and May St have been pulverized, dug out and new base put in Cruickshank has been notified to proceed with the paving
- Hot patching has been on going getting Liscumb Rd, Development Rd, Cayer Rd ready for a single coat of surface treatment
- Crack sealing crew in to work on Riverside Dr in Chesterville and College St,
- Large culvert on Fawcett head line changed and Thompson Rd
- Brushing after Aug/17/11 storm and tree removal
- Removed fence from behind Winchester Fire Stn and in behind the post office
- Started to spot grade some of our roads, graded Baldwin Rd up to the plantation
- Cruick Shank paved May St and Louise St and our crews top soiled along the sides of the new pavement
- The drain between Harmony Corner and SDG#31 has been cleaned and a tile placed down the center and 3" stone with filter cloth put on top for cover
