Subject:	Public Works Report

Up Date: Snow plowing is still taking up most of the road department's time. Hot mix patching and some brushing are filling in the other days. Vehicle and equipment maintenance is ongoing.

I attended the 2011 Municipal Roads Technologies Workshop in early February and received some good road maintenance information as well as a certificate for completion of the course. I also attended the Good Roads Conference last week but found it less informative this year. I did get to talk to some representatives about street lights and I picked up some good information on truck and equipment maintenance reporting and scheduling.

As well as working on budgets this past month I am still trying to get one drain finished and another drain started. The deadline for drainage work is the 15th of March but in talking to South Nation I could get it extended a few days if there is no water flowing.

I had mentioned removing the flower boxes from the village streets in Winchester last fall but had to wait until I could get the bricks to fill in under them. This spring the Down Town Community Volunteers have volunteered to do that job for us, we will work together to get the bricks installed, and the new flower pots.



is in favor. The cost is \$395 up to 24 people and \$295 if we have 25 or more we will also have to supply meals for our participants.


