

Bag limit Reduction

*** I recommend that the bag limit at the curb for waste be reduced to three bags.

REASONS WHY

- * The average for Ontario is 1 to 2 bags
- * We need to have the bag limit down because of the upcoming EPR
- * To keep in line with our Waste Recycling Strategy
- * We need to divert waste to recycling to lessen the amount of waste entering landfill

WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE

* I would like to set a date of August 6th to reduce to 3 bags. Information will be placed in the local papers, website and possibly a flyer to inform the residents of the change.

* Information on how to reduce your waste output will be compiled to help the residents to reduce.
