### 1. Chesterville Water Meter Tender:

The Water Meter Tender was sent out Monday, November 26, 2012 by Matt Morris of Eastern Engineering to Evans Supply (Neptune), Corix Water Products and Elster. The closing date is Friday, December 21<sup>th</sup>, 2012. We hope to have a recommendation for the Jan. 15, 2013 council meeting.

### 2. Chesterville Lagoon Expansion:

Dan, Dave & Blair from OCWA and I visited the Chesterville Lagoons for the scheduled site meeting on November 16<sup>th</sup>. Four engineering firms attended and submitted Proposals – R.V. Anderson, Stantec, Genivar and J.L. Richards. The Tenders were opened on December 5, 2012 by Peter Ollos of OCWA, via conference call; Blair and Dave from OCWA, and Dan and myself were present. Staff recommendation to Council is to accept the Tender from RV Anderson Associates Limited (RVA) for \$ 216,507.00 as recommended by Peter Ollos of OCWA. Please see attached:


### 3. Village of Winchester Sanitary Sewer System Capacity Assessment Study:

JL Richards were commissioned in the spring by OCWA and the Township to develop a working Sewer CAD Model of the Winchester Wastewater Collection System and evaluate the capacity. We met with Brian Hein and Mark Buchanan of JL Richards, Dave, Blair and Peter Ollos of OCWA, Calvin and Angela to discuss the draft. After the discussions, JL Richards were instructed to make some changes and we are waiting for their final draft.

**4. Relocation of the Sanitary Sewer Line on Industrial Dr:**

John Van Bruinessen, 2 Industrial Drive, Chesterville had expressed interest to relocate the Sanitary Sewer Main from his property into the Township right-of-way. We had agreed to split the cost with Mr. Van Bruinessen. I called to follow up with him on December 7, and he explained he was no longer interested in pursuing this project as the other costs were too high.
