Subject:	Administration Report

1) Winchester Centennial Pool:

Our application to the Community Infrastructure Improvement Fund (CIIF) was approved for the replacement of the Winchester Centennial Pool. This includes replacement of the concrete pool and deck, fencing and associated features. We will receive a federal contribution of up to \$141,500. The total project cost is estimated at \$293,000. The balance of the cost will be financed as follows: \$46,500 from reserves, \$5,000 from community support and the balance of \$100,000 will be financed from taxation in future years. We require a budget amendment to reflect this in the 2013 budget.

2) Skating on the Waterfront:

We have secured the use of a pump, hose and nozzle from the Fire Department. We were starting to recruit volunteers for flooding, however, the ice thickness was measured on January 23rd and it was only 3" thick in one of the spots tested, not sufficient to start flooding. Unfortunately the warm weather and rain have increased river flows and required South Nation to open the dam to adjust river levels. The river is therefore not safe and people are advised to staff off the ice.
