- **Winter Control:** We have filled our sand shed with stone dust and mixed 5% salt and added the liquid deicer, we will be monitoring this process carefully.
 - **Training:** Attending Road School in Guelph from May 5th to May 8th, 2013 will be.

 - **Storm sewer for Winchester:** Ongoing.
 - **Tenders:** Working on Salt Dome and Garage Expansion Tender.
Gravel Tender will be sent out on March 15, 2013.
Pavement Tender will be ready to send on March 29, 2013
Surface Treatment Tender is ready to send with council approval. We have 7.3 km of Surface treatment for 2013, before sending the tenders out I would like to know if Council would like to add some roads to this tender I would like an answer for the March 26, 2013 meeting.
 - **Baldwin Bridge:** The Baldwin Bridge as been removed and disposed of, this project was completed on February 21, 2013. The structure was so badly corroded that once the lumber was removed and work began to remove the steel structure it fell apart. Township will be barricading both sides of the bridge as soon as weather permits and taking out the temporary barricades.
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- **Cross Walk from Food Land to Drugstore:** Received confirmation from the County that we do need an engineer's report to go ahead with the project. Engineer report is estimated at \$ 5,000.00. Does Council want to proceed with this project?

- **Mechanic:** The mechanics are working on the water tanker that Winchester fire department has purchased, doing a safety check and installing the new tank.


- **Street Lights:** The Townships one year contract with Dundas Power has ended. I met with Dundas powers and they offered a two year contract for the same price that they quoted last year. Staff's recommendation is that we accept the contract.
I was also talking to Phillips and Erth at Good Roads. These two companies have merged together and will be quoting prices on two different light systems. They are willing to do a pilot project with these systems on Main Street and let Council decide which one they prefer. This would take place at a later date. Their main contractor is Dundas Power.

- **Grey Rd and Helmer Rd Crossing:** The sum of \$256,500.00 was allocated for this project in the 2013 budget. If Council chooses not to go ahead with this project here is a few options were the money could be used to do one or a couple of these projects.
 - 1) Grey Rd Base: \$35,200.00 Surface Treatment: \$21,600.00 Total: \$56,800.00
 - 2) Helmer Rd Base: \$43,000.00 Surface Treatment: \$27,000.00 Total: \$70,000.00
 - 3) Hyndman Rd Base: \$85,300.00 Surface Treatment: \$128,700.00 Total: \$214,000.00
 - 4) McIntyre Rd Base: \$35,000.00 Surface Treatment: 85,000.00 Total: \$120,000.00
 - 5) Resurface existing Surface Treatment = \$ 16,000.00 per km example (Shaw Rd, Cameron Rd, Forward Rd)
