

2 CURBSIDE BAG LIMIT

On February 1st the Township implemented a two bag curbside limit. There were 20 calls received about the limit.

There was 10 calls received concerning why their garbage was not picked up. These callers were unaware of the curbside bag limit. Once the person was informed and reasoning behind our reduction was explained to them, they were all receptive.

There was 4 calls concerning the size of the bags or containers which could be used. The residents were informed of the bag and container size.

There was 6 calls from the farming community with concerns of the difficulty in complying with the limit. I informed each individual on the Plastic Bale Wrap program that we have which also includes the twine.

An updated Bag Limit Notice and Waste Policy were posted on the Township Website which gives all the details on size, limits and quantities.

OPEN FOR SATURDAYS

On February 16th the Boyne Road Landfill was open for residents. The Landfill was used by 10 vehicles.

Next date open is March 16th. The Landfill is open in conjunction with Winchester Fire Departments E-Waste days.
