

GARBAGE REMOVAL

In the last couple of months there have been a number of complaints from residents that claim that garbage has been dropped off on their property. These items include mattresses and couches. In the past, the resident was asked if they were able to deliver the material to the landfill site and if not possible, we supplied them with the phone number for a person who could pick up and deliver it to the landfill. The cost associated with the removal was determined between the two parties.

Another option would be to set a fee for the Township to pick up the waste. Due to the lack of flexibility of the Waste Department since the introduction of right side loading, our resources are limited. We could not respond for a couple of days in certain situations.

I am asking council if the Waste Department is to continue with recommending a private individual for pick up. I have also attached a copy of our Refuse Collection Policy.

POLICY MANUAL	Policy No. <u>43-2012</u>
Township of North Dundas	Effective Date: August 14, 2012
Subject: Refuse Collection	Department: Waste Management

Purpose:

To Establish the Procedures for curbside collection of Waste.

Collection Regulations:

1. Refuse must be placed at curbside no later than 7:00 am on the day of collection.
2. Empty containers must be removed from the curbside no later than 8:00 pm on the day of collection.
3. Each resident may place a maximum of three (3) bags/containers per week. Effective February 1, 2013, each resident may place a maximum of two (2) bags/containers per week.
4. Bags not collected must be removed from the curbside by 8:00 pm on the day of collection.
5. Garbage bags must be securely tied, maximum width of 66 cm (26"), maximum height of 91 cm (36"), and do not exceed 22.5 kg (50 lb). No oversized leaf and yard bags. (exception - leaf and yard waste collection days)
6. Residents may use a garbage container that does not exceed the above measures and weight when full – no 45-gallon drums or totes carts.
7. No person shall place for collection any garbage in front of any address except the address at which the garbage is generated.
8. Recyclable material, tires, demolition and construction material, animal feces, liquids, furniture and appliances, paints, oils, batteries, propane tanks, and other hazardous material will not be collected.
